

2018 PROJECT GOALS: \$105,000

- 1 \$19,500 towards the *RMS Talking Bible Project* in Nepal, Peru and Ecuador. (\$5000 already raised)
- 2 \$32,500 towards a *land purchase* in Nepal for a Bible College and Seminary (Complete).
- 3 **\$6,500** towards the *RMS church building project* in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic.
- 4 **\$5,000** towards *supporting Rev. Bill Green and his wife* in their work.
- 5 \$20,000 towards the *publication work done by CLIR.* Their publishing house prints Reformed

theological books in Spanish which are used by over 1000 pastors and leaders in Latin America. They produce over 5000 books and materials each year and continue to see an increase in demand for solidly Reformed materials. (\$3,000 already raised)

6 \$15,000 towards *tuition support for needy families* at the Tepeyac Christian School (TCS). This school has been running since 1992 and now has over 250 students! Some of those students come from families who cannot afford tuition but would love to send their children to a Christian school.

* URMA is a legal Canadian Charity started by Trinity United Reformed Church in Lethbridge, Alberta, Canada. URMA has a board member on the RMS board and the CRRMP (Costa Rica Reformed Missions Partnership – Bethany URC - Wyoming, MI) overseeing committee. The work with Rev. Green replaces Canadian giving to CLIR through Thunder Bay URC.
